

REDUCTION IN FORCE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there have been changes in circumstances in the form of significant state aid reduction, increased costs of supplies and personnel, over staffing, drop in enrollment and other changes; and

WHEREAS, the board of education is committed to providing the students and patrons of the Leyton Public School District with an educational program that is of high quality and efficient; and

WHEREAS, the board of education believes that the school district may provide some education programs on a reduced basis:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, the programs listed below be reduced by the full-time equivalent (FTE) percentage set out below; that the staff be reduced by the full-time equivalent percent listed below; that the superintendent of schools make necessary assignments and reassignments; and that the superintendent notify the person affected by the reductions:
