8th Grade Science

As part of our 8th grade science unit studying how force affects motion of objects, we were focusing on how the mass of an object affects the amount of force needed to change its velocity. As part of our studies on this, we read an article that covered how different wheelchair designs are necessary for different wheelchair sports. The 8th grade class then came up with the idea to pick a sport and then build a model of a wheel chair that would work best for that sport based upon the design and mass of the chair. For example a lighter wheelchair design would be needed for sports requiring quicker changes in velocity. Students were able to use different materials that represented different masses with paper and styrofoam being the lightest materials and cardboard and popsicle sticks being the most massive building materials. Students drew out a blueprint of their designs then built their designs for their chosen sport including: fencing, mountain trail riding, basketball, rugby and long jumping.

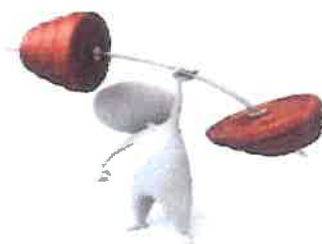

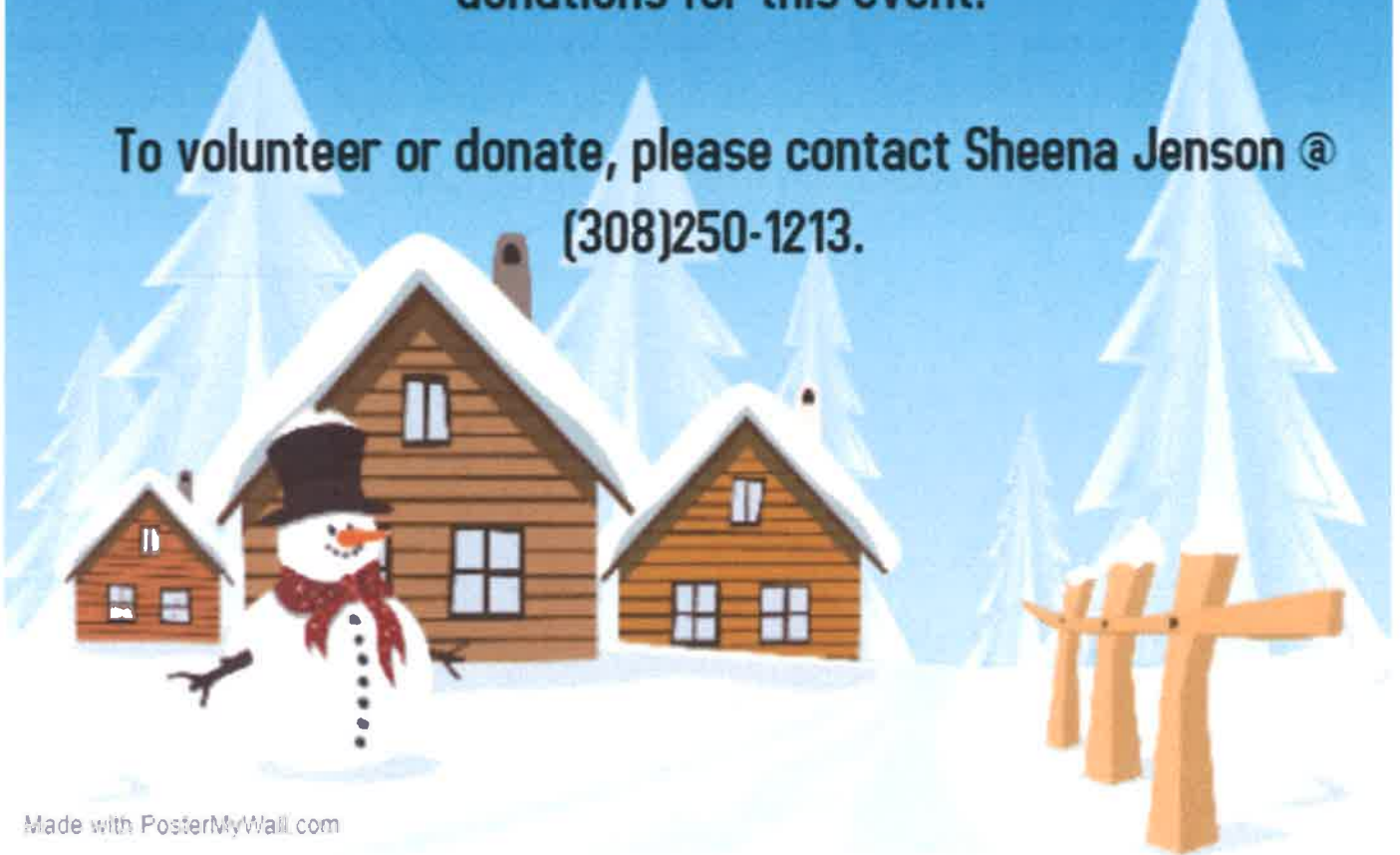
