

Notes from the Counselor

Financial Aid Planning Night has moved from November 20th to December 11th. This was due to the fact that the training on the new FAFSA isn't available till December 6th.

There are four types of financial aid; scholarships, grants, work-study, and student loans.

- Scholarships are awarded by private donors or your college. Some are based on financial need while others are based on criteria such as academics, leadership, athletics, or talents. While they are free money, they are not just given. Scholarships must be earned through hard work, good grades, test scores, participation in extracurricular activities, and leadership.
- Grants are also not repaid and are awarded to students who show financial need. They
 include: Pell Grants, Supplemental Opportunity Grants (SEOG), and College based
 grants.
- Work-Study is based on financial need, this is money you earn from a college-based job to help pay for school expenses.

Student loans are money you borrow and must repay after you're done with college.
 Loans are also available for parents.

All these types of financial aid are based on your FAFSA results. To begin the process of applying for financial aid, you and a parent or guardian must create an FSA ID at studentaid.gov. Your account must be verified before you can complete the FAFSA. This can take 3-5 days, so be sure to apply early. Remember that it is the <u>Free</u> Application for Federal Student Aid, so you should never have to pay for scholarship or grant searches.




