#### Handy Hints for Showing Kindness in Difficult Situations

- Communicate Directly. If you have a concern, please reach out to the right person. Use JMC messaging to contact your child's teacher or the SportsYou app to connect with a coach or sponsor. A direct conversation is often the quickest and most effective way to resolve a problem.
- **Be Curious, Not Critical.** If you're confused about a situation, ask questions. Approach teachers, sponsors, or coaches with a desire to understand their perspective.
- Talk to Your Student. Take a few minutes each day to ask your child about their day. Knowing what's happening in their world can help you stay on top of upcoming events and better understand their experience at school. If they are struggling socially, academically, or athletically, it's important that you talk to them and help them through those tough times.
- Pause Before You Post. Social media can be a powerful tool for connection, but it can also be a kindness-breaker. Before posting a knee-jerk reaction, consider if a quick phone call could solve the issue more effectively and prevent misunderstandings.
- Remember the Website Calendar. The school website calendar is a fantastic resource, but please remember that schedules can change. Our staff works hard to keep communication a top priority, and we're always striving to improve. If you feel we're falling short, please let us know so we can do better.

Our community is our greatest asset. When you see how many people care about Leyton's success, it's clear that everyone is working with the best intentions. Let's remember that kindness is the foundation of our success. By showing patience, understanding, and respect, we can make this the best school year yet. Have a wonderful Month of October: it's the best month in my opinion.



# **Notes from the Principal**






